Community College

- Convenient—close to home
 - Technical training
 - Chance to build academic record
 - Transfer agreements with UC's and CSU's
 - AA degree or Certificate of Completion
 - Admission requirements: high school diploma or age 18
 - No admission testing required
 - California Community Colleges: www.cccco.edu
 - May qualify for no tuition for 2 years

University of California

- 9 campuses to choose from throughout California
 - Competitive GPA advised
 - Bachelor/Master/Doctorate Degrees offered
 - Complete 1 application at www.universityofcalifornia.edu/apply and submit to any of the 9 campuses
 - Accepts applications between October 1st - November 30th
 - High school applicants must have completed “A-G Requirements” with a “C” or better

California State University (CSU)

- 23 campuses to choose from!
 - Bachelor/Master Degrees offered
 - Complete 1 application at <https://www.calstate.edu/apply> and submit to any of the 23 campuses
 - Accept applications between October 1st - November 30th
 - Straight from high school, must have completed “A-G Requirements” with a “C” or better

Private Universities

- Hundreds of private colleges and universities to choose from throughout the U.S.
- Competitive GPA advised
- May require SAT Reasoning or ACT with writing
- Some private institutions, such as Ivy League Schools, Stanford, Massachusetts Institute of Technology and California Institute of Technology are very selective
- **Application deadlines vary, check with university for application deadlines**
